What is EduRoam?

Eduroam (education roaming) is the secure, world-wide Wi-Fi access service developed for the international research and education community.

Where can I use EduRoam?

How do I connect to the EduRoam Wi-Fi Network?

To connect to the wireless eduroam network as a University of Toledo member:

1. Select the eduroam wireless network.
2. Enter your University of Toledo username@rockets.utoledo.edu into the Username field e.g. jsmith@rockets.utoledo.edu
Note: Users will **NOT** be able to authenticate with username@utoledo.edu (jsmith@utoledo.edu) or username (jsmith)
3. Input your University of Toledo UTAD password in the Password field.
4. Click the Accept/Trust this network to connect.
