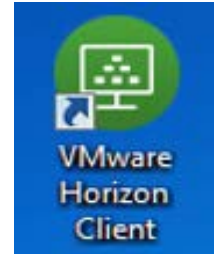


Vlab - Setup Vlab on home PC/Mac/Smartphone/Tablet

Goal – to access UT clinical applications at home/off site on a Mac, PC and on portable devices (tablet/cell)

- Athena, Patientkeeper, MyProMedica
- WebESA (*Use the red "3M" icon on the desktop*)
- HEC/Tracking Board
- Deficiencies/HPF
- UT Email, H-drive and Z-drive
- Vision, etc
- Clinical Portal



PC/MAC - Install Vlab (or update to the latest version)

- a. Visit vlab.utoledo.edu on your browser (Safari or Internet Explorer)
- b. Click "Install VMware Horizon Client"
- c. Select "Windows" for PC or Mac then click "Go to downloads". Click "Download"

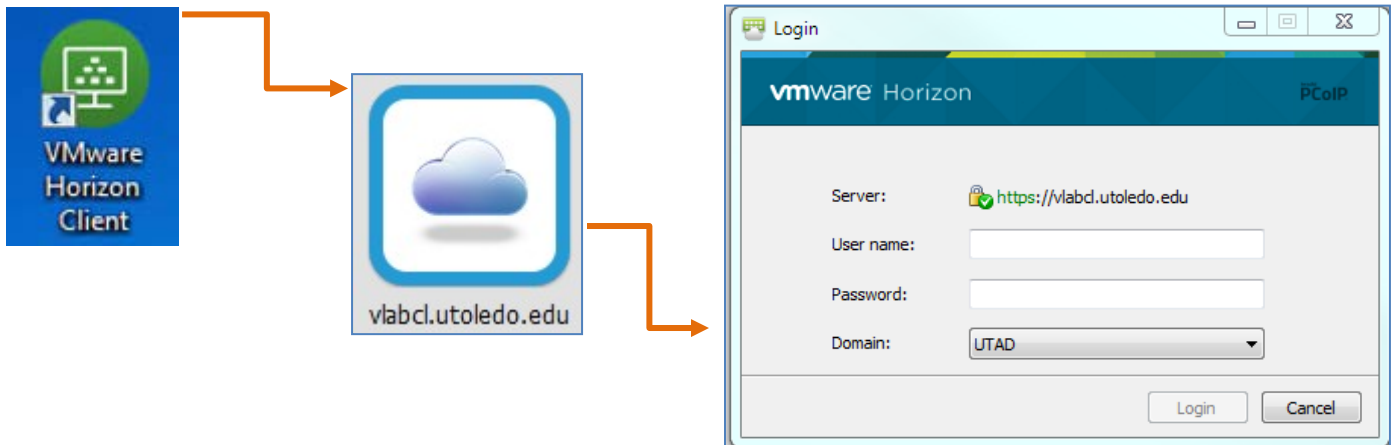
- d. When prompted, type server name: vlabcl.utoledo.edu
 - e. Log into "Clinical Live" using your utad username and password
 - f. **For assistance**, call IT Help Desk at 419-383-2400 (open 24/7)
- To Exit:** Click "Start" → "Log Off" or at the top, click "options" then "disconnect and log off"

IPAD/IPHONE/ANDROID - FREE APP

- a. Go to your *App Store/Play Store*: search for "VMware". Download "VMware Horizon Client"
- b. Touch "VMware View". Type in the connection Server: vlabcl.utoledo.edu
- c. Log into "Clinical Live" using your utad username and password
- d. **For assistance**, call IT Help Desk at 419-383-2400 (open 24/7)
- e. Tap the circular icon on your screen to pull up your virtual keyboard and navigation arrows
- f. **To Exit:** Click "Start" → "Log Off" or at the top, click "options" then "disconnect and log off"

Vlab – How to Log into Vlab

1. Double click on “VMware Horizon View Client”
2. Double click the icon for “vlabcl.utoledo.edu” and log in using your utad credentials



3. Double click “Clinical Live”. Wait for the desktop to display



4. You’ll see a familiar UT desktop. Access the desired application like you would on any UT computer!

What if I cannot connect to Vlab?

Change connection from “PCoIP” to “Microsoft RDP”

1. Right click “Clinical Live”
2. Select “Microsoft RDP”
