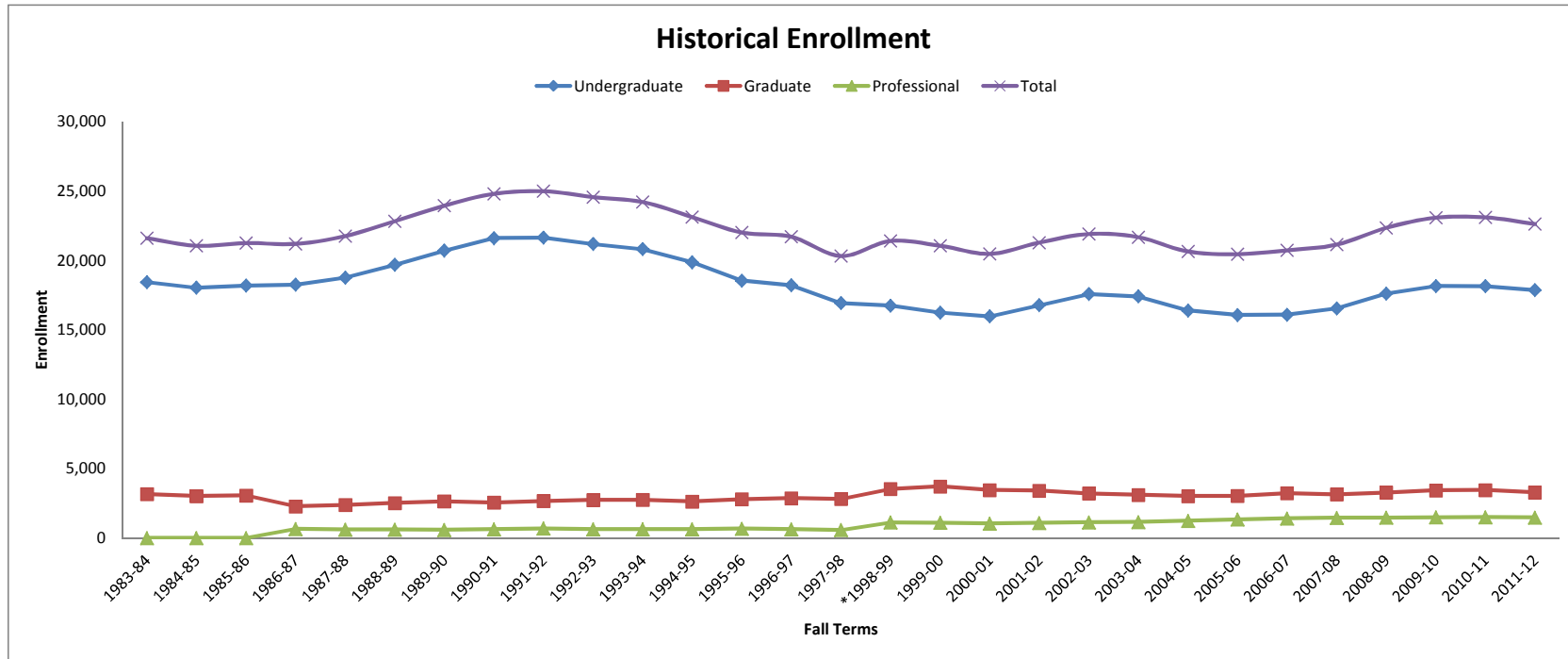

**for Fall Semester in Academic Years 2002-03 through 2011-12 continued**



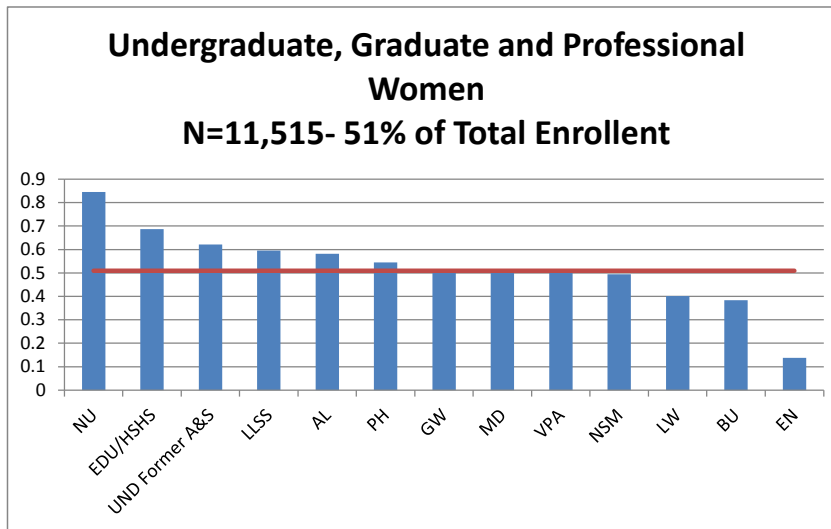
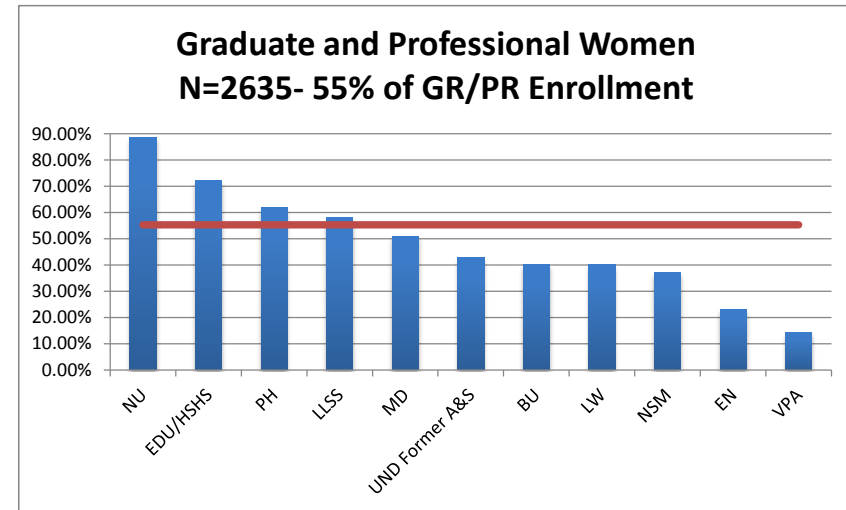
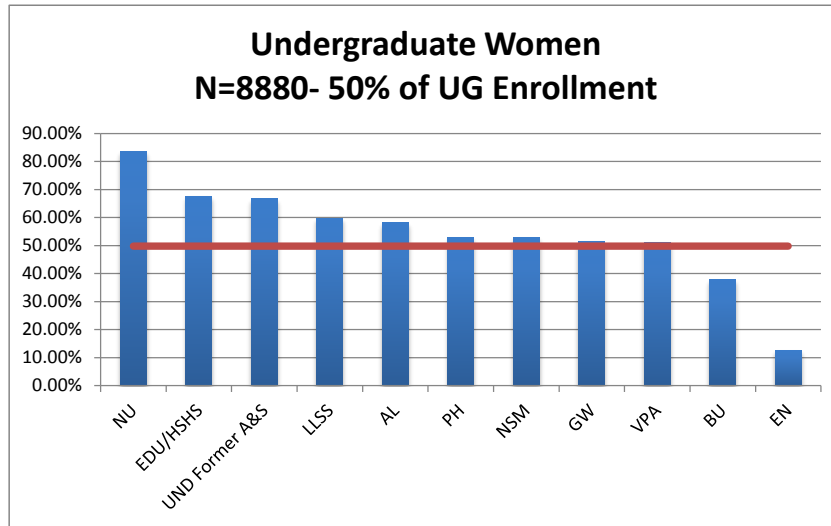

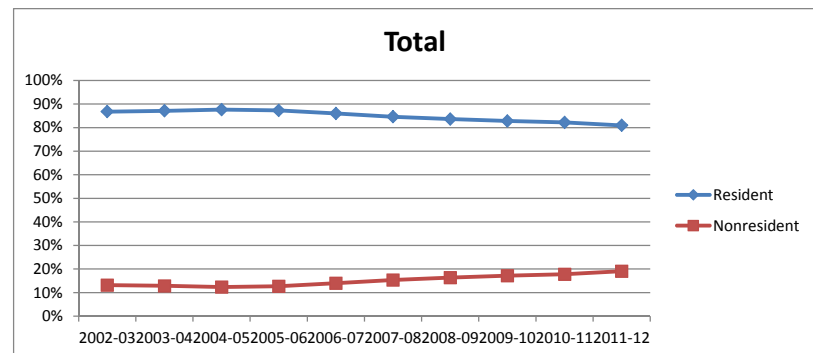
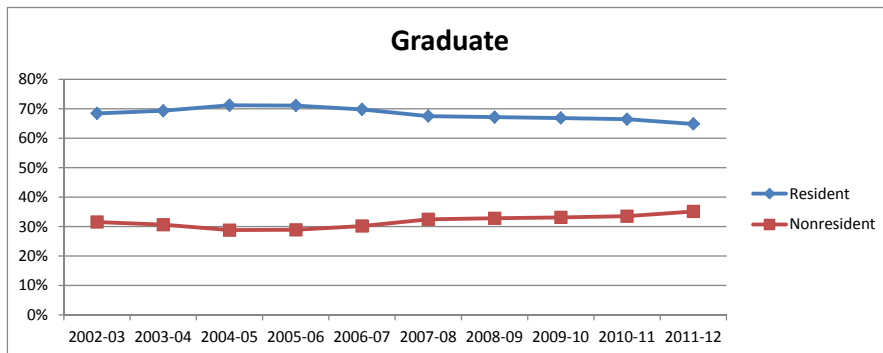
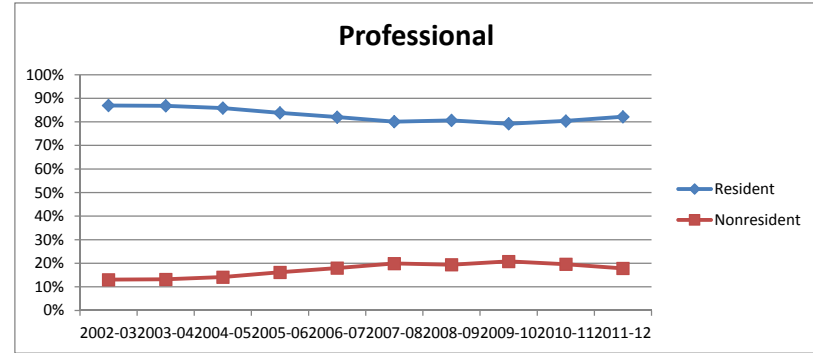
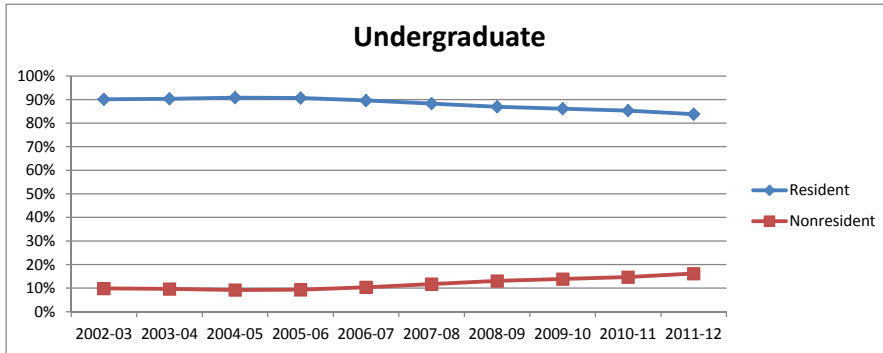

Ohio State Residency as a Percentage of Enrollment by Student Level for Fall Semester in Academic Years 2002-03 through 2011-12



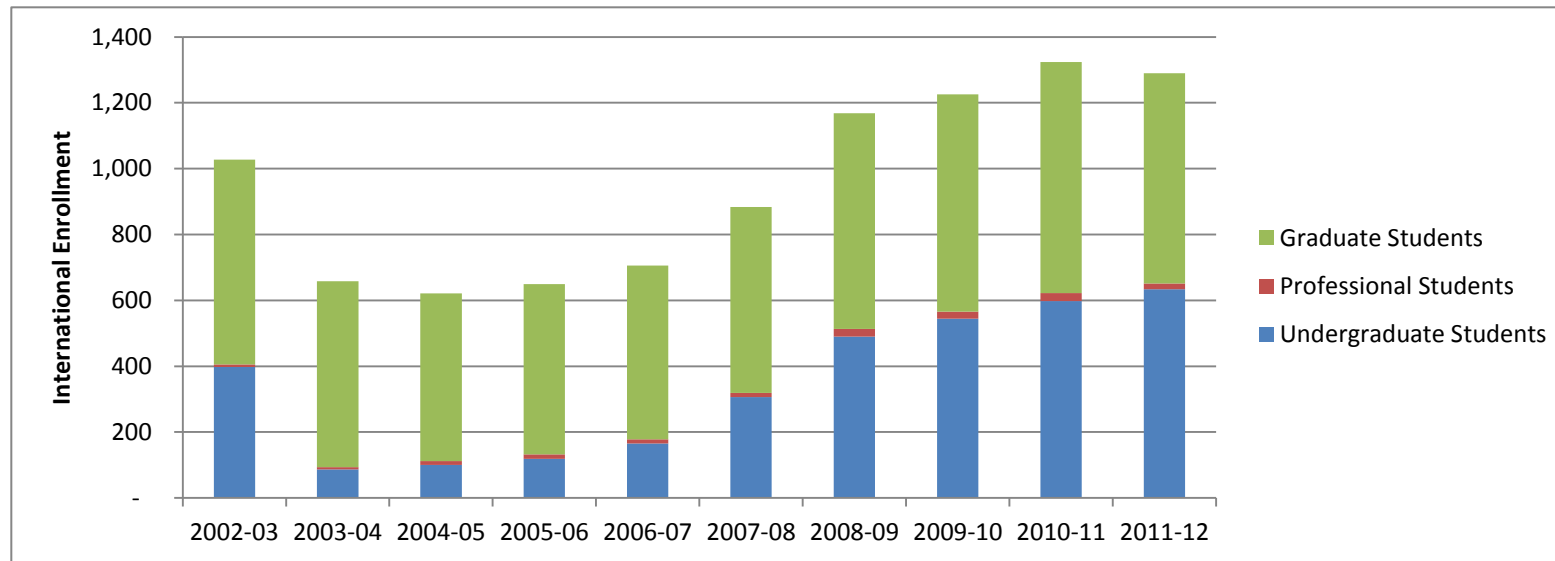

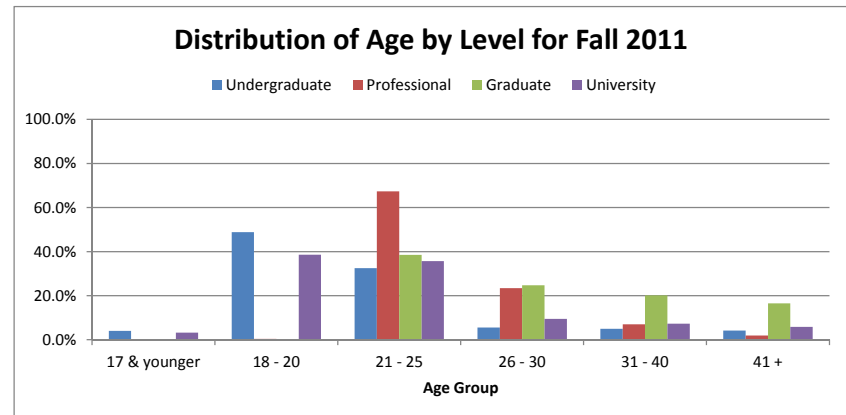
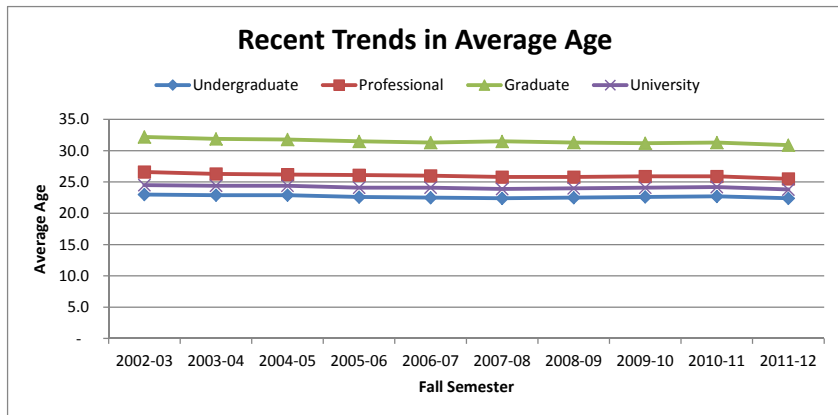

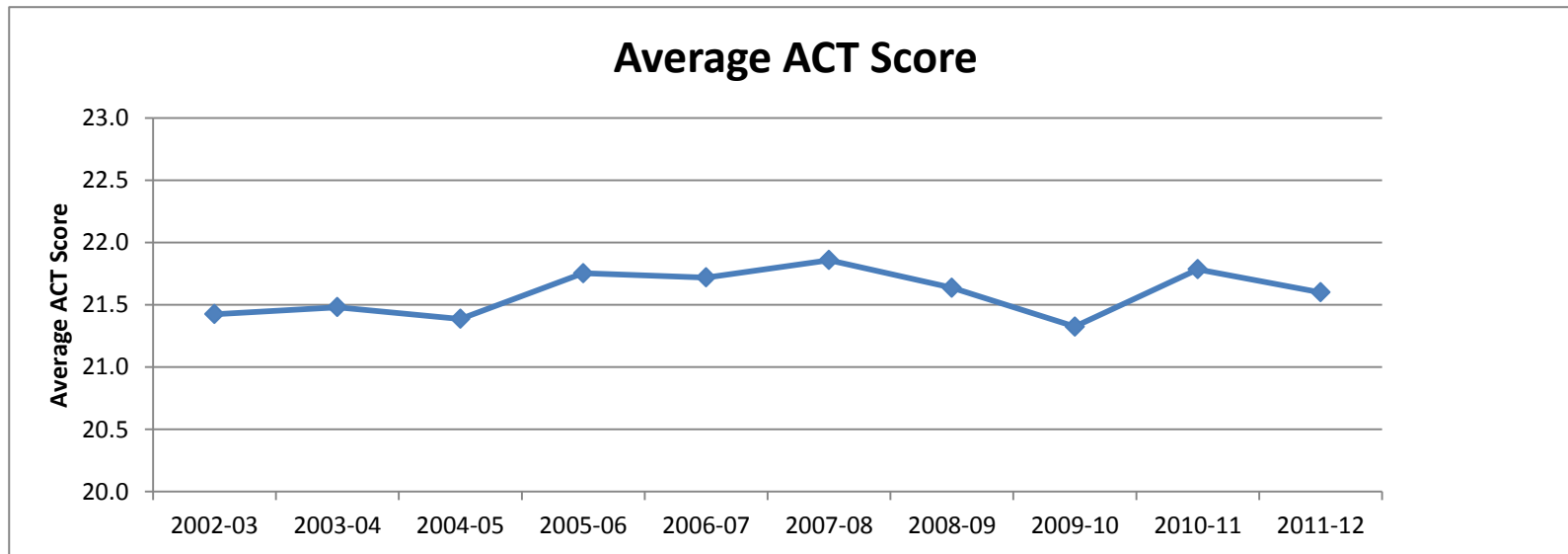

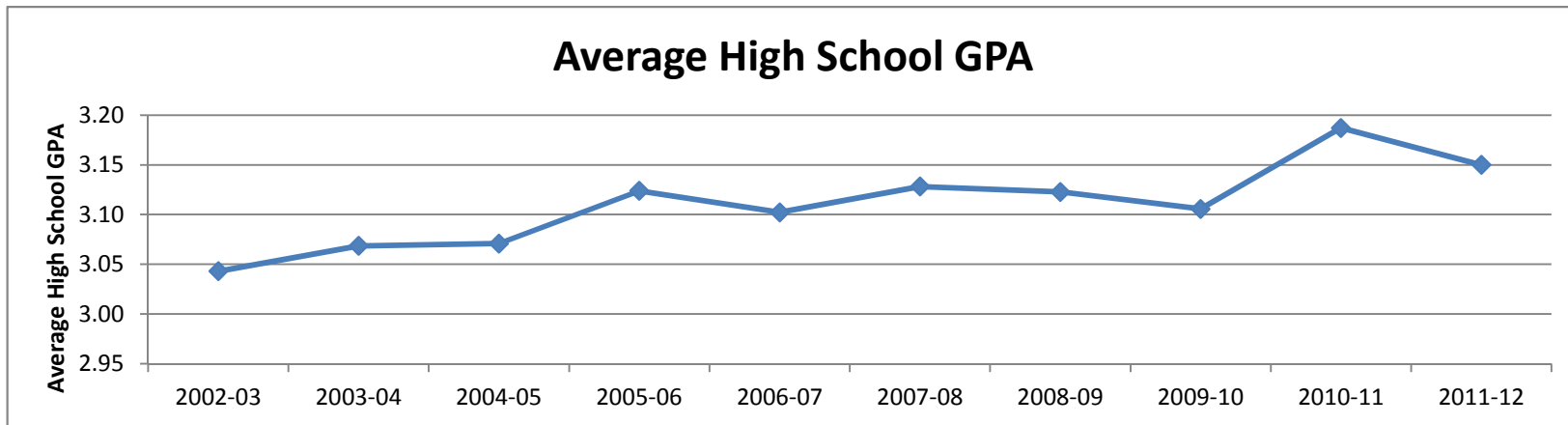
