# DIVERSITY IN LEADERSHIP FELLOWSHIP



The Diversity in Leadership Fellowship, sponsored by the Law and Leadership Institute, LLC, is designed to shape the next generation of diversity and inclusion champions for leadership positions in the legal profession and beyond. Despite consistent efforts to increase diversity in the legal profession and at the highest levels of community leadership, both spheres continue to lag in their goal of increasing racial and ethnic diversity.

In 2016, the American Bar Association adopted Resolution 113:

"Urges all providers of legal services, including law firms and corporations, to expand and create opportunities at all levels of responsibility for diverse attorneys and urges clients to assist in the facilitation of opportunities for diverse attorneys, and to direct a greater percentage of the legal services they purchase, both currently and in the future, to diverse attorneys."

To successfully "expand and create opportunities" for diverse attorneys, those leading in the field must understand the unique challenges associated with the pipeline into the profession as well as the complex issues impacting the recruitment and retention of diverse attorneys.

As sponsor of the Diversity in Leadership Fellowship, the Law & Leadership Institute seeks to create a generation of leaders who are culturally competent, who are confident in their diversity and leadership expertise, and who are committed to championing these issues as they lead now, and as they continue to positions of higher leadership in the future.

**The Fellowship consists of three components:**

- 2 Training on how to successfully implement a legal diversity pipeline program through the Law and Leadership Institute; and

## Law and Leadership Institute

The Law and Leadership Institute prepares high school students from underserved communities for success in high school, college, and the future profession of their choosing. We use the legal profession to inspire students, to develop their understanding of the law's personal impact, and to encourage them to consider law as a possible future career path.

LLI students are promising high school students who face unique challenges. Most LLI students are "at risk" – meaning that they attend a public high school in a major metropolitan Ohio city, and/or are members of groups that are underrepresented in college and in the legal profession. LLI works with these underserved students in each of Ohio's six largest cities to prepare them for academic success in college, and professional success after graduation.

The need is great, and so is LLI's impact. While Ohio has the sixth lowest high school graduation rate for black students in the country (67%), 100% of students who complete the LLI program graduate from high school and more than 90% go on to college.

A model diversity pipeline program, LLI has over 10 years of successful programming that has changed lives and equipped students with the skills and support system needed for academic and professional success. ## Shumaker, Loop, and Kendrick, LLP Diversity Scholarship

The Shumaker Diversity Scholarship provides a \$7,500.00 scholarship to two (2) outstanding first or second year law students who are enrolled at an ABA accredited law school and who participate in the firm's summer associate program, to assist in offsetting his or her law school expenses. The scholarship is in addition to the salary paid to the student for his or her Summer



Associate position.

The Shumaker Diversity Scholarship is available to students who are members of underrepresented or minority groups. Applicants must have outstanding undergraduate and law school academic credentials, and demonstrated leadership abilities and community involvement. Applicants must also demonstrate a commitment to practice law after graduating from law school in the geographic area of one of our firm's offices.

Eligibility for the Shumaker Diversity Scholarship requires that the recipient participate in and complete the firm's summer associate program following his or her first or second year of law school, for a minimum of eight weeks. Shumaker will select the office in which the student will work, but will attempt to place the student in the office location of his or her choice. The scholarship will be paid upon the student's completion of the firm's summer associate program.

Students who are interested in applying for the Shumaker Diversity Scholarship must submit the following documents:

1. A completed application form, together with a current law school transcript. (contact OPD for application, or see Symplicity)
  2. A current resume, including a description of the applicant's academic and leadership skills, community involvement, and personal and professional accomplishments.
  3. A description of why the student believes that diversity is important and how his or her identified diverse background(s) would contribute to that philosophy.
  4. A legal writing sample.
  5. Letters of recommendation from three academic or professional references.
