Nov. 15 **Deadline:** Timely [Application to Register as a Candidate for Admission](#) to the Practice of Law (for applicants in the second year of law school)

Dec. 10 **Deadline:** Late Application to take the February 2019 bar examination
IMPORTANT: Every applicant who intends to take the Ohio bar examination shall file with the Office of Bar Admissions of the Supreme Court an Application to Register as a Candidate for Admission to the Practice of Law by November 15 of the applicant's second year of law school.
