Correction to “On the Science of Rorschach Research”

An error was discovered in the syntax used to classify the depressive spectrum disorders employed in this article. The article stated that 212 of 262 patients had a depressive spectrum disorder, but in actuality 186 patients had one of the diagnoses. Using the corrected diagnostic criterion, regression findings reported in Table 2 are no longer correct. The only statistically significant predictor of a depressive disorder is Scale 2 from the MMPI-2 ($R = .28$). The MMPI-2 Depression content scale and the Rorschach *DEPI* no longer contribute incremental information at a statistically significant level (p to enter of .36 and .19, respectively).

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
