**Course Description**: This course will cover etiology, classification, and treatment of disordered human behavior.

### **Learning Objectives:**

- 1. Students should understand the complexity of defining, classifying, and treating abnormal behavior.
- 2. Students should understand strengths and weaknesses of research contributing to knowledge about abnormal behavior.
- 3. Students should identify primary methods of assessment and treatment of mental disorders.
- 4. Students should be able to describe core features of multiple mental disorders.

# Final Grade will be based on the following:
