Graduation from U.T. with a B.A. in Film is possible with 124 Semester hours, and:

- earning a minimum GPA of 2.0 CUMULATIVELY; IN THE UT CORE AND MAJOR
- complete a minimum of 64 hours at the 2000 level/above;
- complete a minimum of 32 hours at the 3000/4000 level;
- a maximum of 15hrs are allowable outside the College of Arts and Letters

- no more than 2 hours of physical education and 4 hours of performing ensembles, Music 2010/3010; 2190/3190 will count toward the degree;
- general education courses may NOT be taken for Major or Related areas;
- Note that UT core requirements are covered in the college requirements

Note:

- Use this sheet to track your own progress every semester (use pencil not pen).
- At least roughly map out courses throughout college career. Keep pre-requisites in mind.
- Learn to access and read your Degree Audit to track grades and graduation process.

Recommendations:

- Pace FILM courses throughout college career - don't pack them in early or in later years.
- Take FILM 2340 and AR 1000 (THR & FILM section) your first semester.
- Take FILM 2350 second semester of freshman year
- Take English Comp I & II and MATH 1180 your first year. It is possible to test out through AP or CLEP testing
- Take FILM 2310 and 2320 sophomore year (it may be possible to take one spring semester freshman year)
- Note: 2310 and 2320 may NOT be taken in the same semester
- Start foreign language early. It is possible to test out of one or all - see Foreign Language Dept.
