## Freshman Scholarship Opportunities

The University of Toledo Department of Art is seeking to attract visually gifted and enthusiastic students with a strong commitment to the study of art. Selection is based upon evidence of outstanding creative ability and academic excellence. Applicants must have a minimum grade point average of 2.5, and a slide portfolio is required. With the exception of the Sara Jane DeHoff Art Scholarship, financial need is not a consideration. All awards are restricted to University of Toledo students.

The University of Toledo Art Department and The Toledo Museum of Art have had a long, cooperative educational relationship. The Department of Art, which offers degrees in studio art, art history, and art education, has been associated with The Toledo Museum of Art since 1921, and offers an exceptional academic experience. No other art program in the region, and few in the nation, combines a reputation of excellence in teaching with support from a major academic institution and the cultural resources of an internationally renowned museum.

### **Susanna L. Clement Scholarship**

Two \$1,500 awards will be available to entering freshmen majoring in Studio Fine Art who show exceptional promise of creative ability and/or academic excellence. Each award totaling \$6,000 is renewable for three additional years provided the recipient maintains satisfactory academic progress toward the baccalaureate degree.

### **W. Sinclair Walbridge Scholarship**

Up to \$5000 is available to promising and talented entering freshmen who enroll as Studio Fine Art majors at The University of Toledo.

### **Art Interests, Inc. Scholarship**

Over \$1000 is available annually to outstanding entering freshmen pursuing a career in Studio Fine Art or Art Education.

### **Sara Jane DeHoff Art Scholarship**

Up to \$2,000 is given to an entering female freshman majoring in Studio Fine Art, Art Education, or Art History. This scholarship is based on financial need, and is offered for a four-year period with the provision that the recipient maintains a 3.0 GPA.

**APPLICATION PROCEDURE:**

1. Complete the Scholarship Application form and return it with the following supporting material to the Department of Art by March 6:
2. Two letters of recommendation: one from your high school art instructor and one from another adult (counselor, family friend, etc.).
3. A copy of your high school academic record.
4. A slide portfolio of artwork consisting of six two and/or three-dimensional examples of your work. Mark each slide with artist's name, medium, dimensions (HxWxD), and an arrow in the top right-hand corner of the slide. Slide must be 35mm color, in a standard 2"x 2" mount. No glass mounts or thick tape on slides. Please place all slides in a plastic slide holder. Good quality slides are of paramount importance.  
  
JPEG images, 7" in the largest dimension, burned on a CD are also acceptable. Please submit only one image of each piece. No multiple views or details are necessary.
5. Please include a self-addressed #10 business size envelope with adequate postage for return of your slides.
