CURRICULUM REQUIREMENTS FOR THE MINOR IN BIOLOGY SPRING 2003

The following courses must be taken in order to satisfy the requirements for the minor in Biology (total of 22 credit hours):

BIOL 2150	Fundamentals of Life Science I- Lecture, 4 credit hours
BIOL 2160	Fundamentals of Life Science I- Lab, 1 credit hour
BIOL 2170	Fundamentals of Life Science II- Lecture, 4 credit hours
BIOL 2180	Fundamentals of Life Science II- Lecture, 1 credit hour
BIOL 3010	Molecular Genetics, 3 credit hours
BIOL 3030	Cell Biology, 3 credit hours
BIOL 3090	Developmental Biology, 3 credit hours
BIOL 3070	Human Physiology, 3 credit hours
	<u>OR</u>
BIOL 3410	Plant Physiology, 3 credit hours

NOTE:

Some courses are offered every term (BIOL 2150/2160 and 2170/2180); others are offered on a regular basis each fall (BIOL 3010 and 3090); others are offered on a regular basis each spring (BIOL 3030 and 3070); while BIOL 3410 is only offered in alternate spring terms. Thus, it is your responsibility to ensure that you can schedule all the necessary courses.
