The Department of Chemistry is offering 9 summer research positions to high school students as part of the American Chemical Society's Project Seed Program. The purpose of the program is to encourage careers in the chemical sciences. Students will receive a stipend of **\$2,800** for the summer. Students are expected to work in the lab full time for at least 8 weeks.

Requirements are:

- Successful completion of 1 year of high school chemistry.
- Family income below \$36,620 (or \$54,930 if other criteria are met). Other limits apply for families with more than 4 members. Note: Parents will need to certify your family income for 2008 by submitting a copy of their IRS form 1040.
