NOTE: **All majors** must include 1 cr. of Chamber Mus. Ens.

Keyboard concentration: substitute 3 sem. of Large Vocal Ens. And 1 sem. MUS 3580 for Piano 1-IV. Must also take 2 sem. of MUS 2/3050 Accompanying as part of large ens. requirements.

Guitar concentration: take 4 cr. of large vocal ensemble as part of large ens. requirements. MUS2/3050 Guitar Ensemble may count as a large ens. requirement.

All majors enrolling Fall, 2003 must take a content reading course.

All majors must perform a senior recital (half or full) at a minimum proficiency of Level 6.

All majors must attend 16 non-departmental concerts/recitals; 64 departmental concerts/recitals prior to student teaching.

All majors must perform during MUS 1000:001 - 6 times (minimum 3 as soloist) prior to senior recital hearing.
