## **Undergraduate Summer Research and Creative Activity Program (USR&CAP)**

This competitive program provides a stipend (\$2,750) and a research supplies budget (\$250) for undergraduate students to conduct research during summer 2007. USR&CAP is open to UT undergraduates in all disciplines.

## **First Year Summer Research Experience (FYSRE)**

This competitive program provides a stipend (\$2,750) and research supplies budget (\$250) for freshmen to conduct research during their first summer as UT students (summer 2007). FYSRE is open to UT freshmen in all disciplines.

Students can apply to the USR&CAP and FYSRE programs Nov. 1, 2006, through Feb. 2, 2007. FYSRE applicants also will be considered for the USR&CAP program.
