## Accounting at UT

Accountants work as financial consultants who help their clients or employers find creative solutions to business problems. Accountants provide the necessary information and analysis companies need to become more effective and efficient. Accountants perform a wide range of services, requiring a broad-based skill set.

UT's accounting program gives students the skills and experiences to become certified public accountants (CPAs) or work in private or governmental accounting. And our accounting graduates have traditionally had a CPA exam pass rate well above most public universities in Ohio.

Accounting majors at UT have typically received the largest amount of scholarships in the College of Business Administration. They can also join Beta Alpha Psi, a national honorary accounting fraternity. In addition, students can gain real-world experience through numerous well-paid internship opportunities that often lead to full-time positions after graduation. This lets students work with accomplished professionals in the accounting field while earning college credit and money.

### What to expect when you graduate

Students graduating with accounting degrees have the highest average entry-level salaries of any major within the College of Business Administration. Accounting jobs can be found in public accounting, corporate accounting and non-profit or governmental accounting.
