Groundbreaking at UT held for Savage business center

The University of Toledo held a groundbreaking ceremony yesterday for the \$15.4 million Savage & Associates Complex for Business Learning and Engagement.

The event drew about 280 people to the site on the Main Campus, north of Stranahan Hall, where the 54,0000-square-foot building will be constructed. The complex, slated to be complete and ready for students by the 2009 fall semester, will be connected to Stranahan Hall, which houses the university's college of business administration.

The new business complex, which will be a "green" building, will house 10 classrooms, five action-learning labs to connect students with the business community, and a 40-seat board room - all with state-of-the-art technology.
