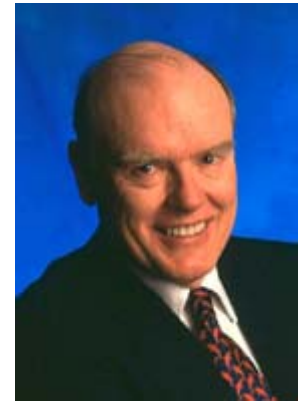


Former Treasury secretary to speak to area leaders

The former secretary of the U.S. Treasury Department and current chairman of Cerberus Capital Management will present "Ohio and the Global Economy: A View From the Top," and will discuss the globalization of northwest Ohio and southeast Michigan.

The Global Leadership Forum was created to annually bring in world-renowned speakers to address the Toledo business community, and to provide an environment for regional business leaders to talk about contemporary business issues, discuss current leadership topics, and explore trends and future needs,

"One of the goals of the college is to begin to engage in conversations that add value, knowledge and experience to businesses with whom we partner in the community," said Dr. Thomas Gutteridge, dean of the College of Business Administration. "John Snow is an influential voice in business and the region, and we can benefit by listening to what he has to say.

On Jan. 30, 2003, Snow was confirmed secretary of the U.S. Department of the Treasury, working closely with President George W. Bush on a broad array of economy policy issues. In October 2007, Snow was named chairman of Cerberus Capital Management.

Snow holds a master's degree from Johns Hopkins University, a PhD in economics from the University of Virginia, a JD from George Washington University, a BA from The University of Toledo and numerous honorary degrees. He also has served on the faculty of several academic institutions.
