General Business Minor

A. Prerequisites

A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.25 is required in the following prerequisite courses or their equivalents.

ECON 1150 (Macro) and 1200 (Micro), or equivalent.....	3-6 hrs
MATH 1260 and 1270 , or equivalent	3-6 hrs
BUAD 2060 Business Statistics, or equivalent	3 hrs
BUAD 1020 * Microcomputer Appl., or equivalent.....	3 hrs

* Students may demonstrate computer proficiency through Microsoft certification or placement test.

General Business Minor (cont.)

- Six business courses (18 hrs) are required beyond the prerequisite courses
- A minimum grade of C (2.0) or better is required in each of the six business courses
- Maximum of 2 courses (6 hrs) may transfer towards the six business courses
