



ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP FUND 2009 - 2010

National City, now a part of PNC is committed to assisting outstanding Junior and Senior level students of full-time or part-time (*minimum 6 credit hours*) status majoring in Business Administration at the University of Toledo.

Requirements:

- Recipients shall be U.S. citizens from National City or PNC territories (*Connecticut, Delaware, District of Columbia, Florida, Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, New Jersey, New Hampshire, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Missouri, Virginia, Wisconsin*).
- Recipients shall be **Junior** or **Senior** undergraduate students majoring in **Business Administration** at the University of Toledo.
- Recipients shall maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5.
- Preference will be given to **minorities** and those with involvement in campus activities and/or employment.
- Financial need will be taken into consideration when awarding this scholarship as determined by the Office of Student Financial Aid of The University of Toledo.
- Applicants will be required to submit an essay at the time of application (*see requirements listed below*).
- Applicants will be required to submit at least one letter of recommendation from a person familiar with the applicant's academic abilities. Students are also encouraged to submit up to two additional letters of recommendation addressing either personal qualities or academic ability.

Essay Requirements:

Please address the following questions in the body of your essay. The essay must be typed and double-spaced and should not exceed 500 words in length.

- What is National City's responsibility to the community?
- What values do you possess which will help you to become successful in your career?

Awards:


1. Recipients of this award will be chosen on the basis of financial need, scholastic ability, campus involvement, written essay, references, and recommendations from appropriate sources.
2. The scholarship may be applied to all educational expenses for the academic year.
3. Preference will be given to **minorities** and those with campus involvement.
4. The scholarship is not automatically renewable. Previous recipients may reapply.
5. Recipients of this scholarship shall be selected by the collaborative efforts of National City and the College of Business, in accordance with the criteria stated above and awarded in the name of National City, now a part of PNC - Northwest Ohio Region.
