## Prebusiness Administration at UT

The prebusiness administration program is designed to allow students to study in University College during their first two years, then transfer into the College of Business Administration. Students taking all of the courses and meeting certain academic requirements may complete an associate of arts degree and be accepted into the upper division within the College of Business Administration for completion of a bachelor's degree.

UT's University College and College of Business Administration work closely together. Students are able to begin the program in the small class-size

environment for prebusiness classes and complete their degree in the nationally accredited College of Business Administration. They gather knowledge about the real-world of business through theories and concepts to provide the best learning experience.

### What to expect when you graduate

An associate of arts degree will be awarded by University College, but this degree is for transfer purposes only. By itself, the degree is not designed for entry directly into the workplace and does not prepare graduates for technical positions. If you are interested in technical employment, you should pursue one of the other business technology programs. However, upon completion of a bachelor's degree in business, job opportunities are unlimited.
