Previously approved positions where offers have been extended by HR will be honored. All other previously approved positions will need to be reviewed and re-approved by Dr. Jacobs prior to HR extending an offer. Subject: Budget impact

As I'm sure you are all aware, the FY 10-11 budget for the state of Ohio is currently in a state of flux. While I have great confidence in the Governor, Chancellor, House and Senate and confidence in their understanding of the value of higher education as the State's best investment; the current shortfall is in the range of 2.5 Billion.

We may not, therefore, have a finalized budget for several days or even weeks. Until we do, until the State's budget is finalized, I feel compelled to take the following actions:

1. The ICU project is on hold. Hopefully we will release this project in a week or two.
2. The pharmacy building will continue in its planning and drawing work, but I have directed that the cutting and welding of the steel structural work not proceed until we have a finalized State budget.
3. No person, not faculty, not custodians, not part time, not full time is to be hired without my signature and upon the recommendation of the appropriate VP or Provost.
4. The 14 M recently approved by the Board for upgrades to the wireless network on the main campus and the Digital Campus at HSC will be held until the state budget is finalized.
5. No procurement contract, presently being negotiated or processed, will be finalized without the written approval of Scott Scarborough, CFO.
