Details:
The UTPD is investigating burglary incidents which occurred in McComas Village on Main Campus in the early morning hours of December 25, 2011. Unknown suspect(s) entered McComas Village units by shattering the glass of lower-level windows allowing access into the interior of the McComas Village units. Once inside, suspect(s) stole items including electronics and flat-screen televisions.
