


University of Toledo Police Department Community Awareness Bulletin

On January 13th, 2013 the Toledo Police Department received a report of a burglary occurring at University Park Apartments, 1517 Secor Road. The victim indicated he was returning to his residence at 4:15am when just outside his apartment, he was approached by four unknown males. The victim indicated two of the suspect males initiated a physical confrontation. The victim fled the scene. When the victim returned to his apartment, he discovered the door had been kicked open and several items including a flat screen TV and a lap top computer were missing.

No weapons were reported. Suspect descriptions were vague at the time of the report.
