Just after midnight Sunday morning, April 10, 2011, a UT police officer arrested a 35-year-old Toledo man after the man brandished a handgun in the parking lot of a bar near the Main Campus.

The UT officer was assisting a student who had locked her keys in her car in the parking lot of the Omni bar, in the 2500 block of West Bancroft Street. The officer witnessed the white male suspect threaten another man with the weapon. The officer ordered him to drop the gun. The suspect fled, but was caught and charged with weapons violations.

UT Police would like to remind students to always be aware of their surroundings. Never lower your level of awareness by consuming too much alcohol and be selective when choosing entertainment venues.
