Toledo Police is investigating a robbery which occurred just before midnight on Wednesday night April 27, 2011. The male victim reported his vehicle, which was parked and left running, was stolen from the 1600 block of Roosevelt. The victim spotted the vehicle and followed it to the 2300 block of Torrey Hill. At that location two suspects confronted the victim and brandished revolvers. The victim fled. The vehicle was later recovered by the team policing unit at that location.

The victim indicated there were three suspects in total, described as black males 16 - 18 years of age. Two suspects had weapons. If you have any information about this crime please contact crime stoppers at 419.255.1111.
