UT Police have been told of an aggravated burglary that occurred Tuesday, May 3, 2011, in the 3000 block of College Drive. According to Toledo Police a female resident of Campus Village Apartments awoke around 3:20 a.m. to find an unknown male forcing open the front door of her apartment. Once inside, the suspect threatened to harm the victim if she did not give him certain items. The victim cooperated and the suspect left with an iPad and a laptop computer. The victim was unsure if the suspect had a firearm. She believed a second male assisted. The victim was not able to provide suspect descriptions at the time of the report.
