Toledo Police are investigating an assault that occurred around 12:40 a.m. on Sunday, July 24, 2011 near the intersection of Perth and Olds Avenue in the Bancroft Hills area of the City of Toledo. Four victims told police that they were walking together in the area when they were approached by a group of suspects (which included males and a female). The suspects then attacked the victims for no reason, punching some of the victims about the face. When victims called 911, the suspects fled.

One victim is currently being treated at a local hospital and his condition is unknown. The other victims were treated for minor injuries at the scene by Toledo Fire Department.

### Suspect Descriptions:

SUSPECT 1: Black Male – Approximately 14 years of age – Wearing light blue clothing.

SUSPECT 2: Black Male – Approximately 14 years of age – Unknown clothing description.

SUSPECT 3: Black Male – Approximately 14-16 years of age – Unknown clothing description.

SUSPECT 4: Black Male – Approximately 14-16 years of age – Unknown clothing description.

SUSPECT 5: Black Male – Approximately 12-14 years of age – Unknown clothing description.

SUSPECT 6: Black Female – Approximately 13-16 years of age – Unknown clothing description.
