The Toledo Police Department is investigating an aggravated robbery that occurred around 7:20 p.m. on Wednesday, August 17, 2011 in the Bancroft Hills neighborhood.

The male victim told police he was in his automobile slowly driving down an alley near the 1600 block of Roosevelt when he was approached by a male suspect. The suspect asked the victim a question and two other suspects appeared, produced a gun and ordered the victim out of the car. The victim did not comply and after a physical struggle the suspects fled on foot north on Roosevelt.

The armed suspect is described as a black male, about 16 years of age, 5'9" 140 lbs, dreadlock hair, wearing a light blue t-shirt.

The second suspect is described as a black male, about 16 years of age, 5'9" 140 lbs, short hair, white t-shirt and black shorts, pimples on face.

The third suspect is also described as 5'9" 140 lbs with a white t-shirt.
