The Toledo Police Department is investigating an off campus aggravated burglary that occurred around 9:30 p.m. on Sunday, September 18, 2011 at the University Parks Apartments in the 1500 block of Secor Road. The male victim reports a suspect entered his apartment, brandished a handgun and stole cash. The victim was unharmed.

The victim describes the suspect as a black male, thin build, 6'2," wearing black pants and a black t-shirt. Anyone with information on this crime is urged to contact Toledo Police Crime Stoppers at 419.255.1111.

- Most criminals look for easy access to a residence or move to another. Make sure you lock all doors leading into your residence from the outside.
- Keep garage doors closed when not in use.
