## **UPDATE: SUSPECTS SENTENCED**

Travis Bell, 18, of Toledo, has been sentenced to 10 months in jail for charges stemming from an incident on September 6, 2011 at Carlson Library. Bell was preying upon patrons, stealing items including a pair of headphones. When confronted by one of his victims, Bell threatened to harm her. UT Police Department was contacted and officers responded and apprehended Bell at the scene.

Davon Tapp, 40, of Toledo, was sentenced to 38 months in prison for charges stemming from burglaries committed over the summer in Health and Human Services and Wolfe Hall, as well as locations in the city of Toledo. Tapp was identified by a tipster who saw him featured in a University of Toledo Police Crime Awareness Bulletin.
