Toledo Police are investigating a robbery that occurred around 12:30 a.m. Saturday, November 19, 2011 in the 2500 block of Oakwood Avenue near Alvin Street. The victim told police that while he was walking on the sidewalk along Oakwood Avenue, he was approached by a lone male suspect who brandished a gun and demanded the victim's phone. The victim cooperated and the suspect fled on foot.
