UT Police are investigating a report of an arson fire in Carter East. According to a pair of roommates, around 6:10 p.m. on Sunday, Dec. 4, someone knocked on the door to their room. When they opened it they discovered a burning piece of paper. It appears the paper had been taped to the door and lit on fire. The only damage was to the piece of paper.

Arson is classified as when someone knowingly creates a substantial risk of physical harm to any property or another by means of fire.

Arson to a state building is a felony of the fourth degree.
