A UT student reported to Toledo Police he was the victim of a robbery while walking in the 2100 block of Wyndhurst Avenue during the early morning hours of March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2011.

The male victim reported at approximately 2:00 am, he was walking with a friend when approached by several unknown males. The victim was accused of damaging a vehicle belonging to one of the suspects. The victim was then physically assaulted by the suspects. The suspects took cash from the victim and fled. The victim was treated at a local hospital for injuries.

No specific suspect information was provided at the time this report was taken.
