Toledo Police are investigating an armed robbery which occurred Wednesday, March 30, 2011 around 12:30 a.m. in the 2100 block of Perth Street.

A male victim reported two (2) suspects exited a vehicle and displayed a gun and demanded his wallet. The victim complied. The victim told police he was struck on the head by the suspects before he fled the scene.

The two suspects were described as black males, about 20 years of age, around 5' 11" and 165 lbs. They were both wearing a grey sweatshirt and dark jeans. No specific vehicle description was provided.
