

The University of Toledo – CRIME STATISTICS

The University of Toledo Police Department, in compliance with the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998, has compiled and published the following crime statistics. The Campus section – crimes that occurred on the Main, Health Science, or Scott Park campuses – has been broken down into four sub-categories: Main (Bancroft) Campus, Health Science Campus, Scott Park Campus, and Residence Halls.

The Non-Campus category encompasses all crimes that occurred at off-campus fraternity and sorority housing and apartments being leased by the University, as well as incidents at the Lake Erie Research Center, Stranahan Arboretum, and the University's remote classrooms at the Toledo Museum of Art. Crimes reported to UT Police or the City of Toledo Police Department that occurred off campus, but on property immediately adjacent to the Bancroft or Scott Park campuses are listed in the Public Property section.
