Subject: Robbery attempt



SYNOPSIS:

The University of Toledo Police Department is investigating an incident occurring Wednesday, September 3rd on the second floor of Dowling Hall at 1:15 pm, in the Department of Surgery on the Health Science Campus. A female employee reported she briefly left her office with the door open and returned to discover her door partially closed and an unknown male behind the office door, rifling through her purse. The male quickly fled when confronted. No injuries were reported and no weapons were seen. The victim did not report any property missing.

Victim described the suspect as follows:

black male, light complexion - year of age estimated mid to late 20s, approximately 6'0", slender build, short dark hair – Wearing: cream colored polo shirt with a non-descript design on the shirt, khaki pants with brown belt.
