

# PROPER HANDLING OF BIOHAZARD / INFECTIOUS WASTE

## Biohazard "AUTOCLAVED" Container



The following hazards must be disposed of in a Biohazard "autoclave" container:

- Bacteria
- Cells/Cultures
- Biologically Contaminated Broken Glass
- Biologically Contaminated Gloves
- Blood Contaminated Items

Biohazard container must be:

- Labeled on two sides
- A leak-proof plastic container
- Lined with a red biohazard bag

## Biohazard "INCINERATED" Container

The following hazards must be disposed of in a Biohazard "incinerated" container:

- Research/Teaching Specimens
- Animal/Human Tissues

Biohazard container must be:

- Labeled on two sides
- Lined with a red biohazard bag



## "SHARPS" Container



- Place needles inside "Sharps" container

Sharps container must be:

- Affixed to the wall, or
- Designed for tabletop disposal
- Dog dish

*\* Do not store these containers on the floor*
