

## FAQ REGARDING AHEC ROTATIONS

- In all regions, travel time from housing to clinical site is usually not more than ½ hour.
- All housing is at no cost to the student.
- Sites that do not provide housing are as follows:
  - BAHEC: Napoleon, Metamora, Delta, Wauseon and Archbold
  - LAHEC: All sites provide housing.
  - SAHEC: Bowling Green
- Occasionally, housing is shared with other learners. The other person may be someone of the opposite gender. However, if you have a roommate, they will be the same gender.
- Housing is arranged through the AHEC center prior to the beginning of the rotation. Rules apply to all housing; no pets, smoking, overnight guests, or open flames. AHEC centers make every effort to maintain a safe environment.
- Weekend and night call is rotation specific. This is generally worked out between the preceptor and student at the beginning of the rotation.
- Computers and the internet are available at housing, clinical site or hospital.
