1. Proposals, recommendations, and resolutions forwarded to Council with the disposition:

Proposals submitted January 20, 2016

- SAC proposes an after-spring break walking taco lunch for students in March 2016 to be held in the lobby of the 3rd floor. The dean has approved funds for this event in the amount of \$269. SAC would like to have College Council help solicit faculty participation for this event at the February college meeting. SAC will provide a list of kinds of help needed before then.
- SAC proposes to hold a Recharging Station, which will include healthy snacks and drinks during spring exam week for students to be held in the lobby of the 3rd floor. The dean has approved funds for this event in the amount of \$160. SAC would like to have College Council help solicit faculty participation for this event at the March college meeting. SAC will provide a list of kinds of help needed before then.

Disposition:

- SAC received no communication from Council on the above proposals.
- The proposals were sent again to Council in the SAC monthly report on March 16, 2016 (see below).
- No response was received a second time so at the recommendation of committee members, an email was sent to Council Executive Committee members on March 24, 2016 asking for a response.
- Lambert received an email from Jenny Denyer on March 28th stating that Council would discuss this at their next meeting on March 29th.
- No response was received a third time from Council so on April 12th Lambert emailed the Executive Committee asking for a response again.
- A response was received April 13th from Marcella Kehus telling SAC that she thought that proposals had been approved at the last meeting. She attached to the email minutes from Council.

SAC has not yet received a response from Council on the proposal submitted January 20, 2016 to allow SAC to host an after-spring break walking taco lunch for students after spring break (see

proposal submitted below). SAC will rescind this proposal since the date for the event has passed and the dean will be notified that funds are no longer needed.
