CHANGES AND REASONS FOR CHANGES

In order to improve the quality of the students who complete our program, we are requesting to change the grade requirement for moving through the cohort classes. Currently, students are required to earn a grade of C or higher in all cohort courses before moving on to the next cohort. We would like to raise that expectation to a grade of B or higher.

The data we have suggests that students who earn a grade of C in any cohort class are those who have the most difficulty in successfully completing field work. These students also tend to show less enthusiasm and passion for teaching.
