CHANGES AND REASONS FOR CHANGES

The state of Ohio's Department of Education mandates that teacher candidates take 12 hours of literacy-related coursework that address particular aspects of literacy acquisition and development. To adhere to these requirements and maintain a consistent number of course hours for students, the following changes are being proposed. 1. Updating and renaming a CI 3400 (formerly known as "Literacy Issues," and to be renamed "Foundations of Literacy") to meet requirements to provide for students a broad overview of contemporary challenges for literacy instruction and current research-based understandings of literacy development; 2. Collapsing two courses (CI 4470 Reading Assessment And Diagnosis & CI 4480 Reading Assessment And Remediation Practicum) into just one course (to be named CI 4470 Literacy Assessment and Remediation) that integrates and makes more cohesive the cycle of assessment and instructional adaptations necessary in contemporary classrooms. These two courses are required of all teacher candidates in Early Childhood, Middle Grades and Special Education programs. The remaining 6 credits of literacy-related coursework vary depending on the specific program and are not being modified at this time.
