## Dependency Appeal Renewal 2011-12

Dear Student:

If you applied for and were granted independent status for the 2010-11 academic years, please use this form to reapply for financial aid for the 2011-12 academic years and update your information. If you can answer **YES** to any one of the following questions, you are automatically considered an independent student by the U.S. Department of Education and do not need to file a Dependency Appeal Renewal:

- Were you born before January 1, 1988?
- As of today, are you married? (Also answer "yes" if you are separated but not divorced.)
- At the beginning of the 2011-12 school years, will you be working on a master's or doctorate program (such as an MA, MBA, MD, JD, PhD, EdD, or graduate certificate, etc.)?
- Are you currently serving on active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces for purposes other than training?
- Are you a veteran of the U.S. Armed Forces?
- Do you have children who will receive more than half of their support from you between July 1, 2011 and June 30, 2012?
- Do you have dependents (other than your children or spouse) who live with you and who will receive more than half of their support from you, now and through June 30, 2012?
- At any time since you turned 13, were both of your parents deceased, were you in foster care or were you a ward/dependent of the court?
- As determined by a court in your state of legal residence, are you or were you an emancipated minor?
- As determined by a court in your state of legal residence, are you or were you in legal guardianship?
- At any time after July 1, 2010, did your high school or school district homeless liaison determine that you were an unaccompanied youth who was homeless?
- At any time on or after July 1, 2010, did the director of an emergency shelter or transitional housing program funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development determine that you were an unaccompanied youth who was homeless?
- At any time on or after July 1, 2010
- At anytime on or after July 1, 2010, did the director of a runaway or homeless youth basic center or transitional living program determine that you were an unaccompanied youth who was homeless or were self-supporting and at risk of being homeless?

If you are considered an independent student by the U.S. Department of Education, you may apply for financial aid using FAFSA on the Web at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov).

If you are not considered an independent student by the U.S. Department of Education, but your mitigating circumstances that permitted us to override your dependency status previously have not changed, please submit the items below to reaffirm your independent student status. Renewals submitted without the required documentation will not be reviewed.

1. A completed and signed 2011-2012 paper Free Application for Student Aid (FAFSA) available on our website under common forms
2. A completed and signed 2011-2012 Verification Worksheet available on our website under common forms
3. A signed copy of your 2010 federal IRS tax return (Form 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ)
4. A copy of all your 2010 W-2(s)
5. An updated letter from you reaffirming that your independent student status has not changed
6. Updated documentation from a third party regarding the current status of your relationship or contact with your parent(s)
