

The University of Toledo
Scholarship Terms and Conditions for the
President's Summit and President's Community Awards

1. The awarded scholarship begins in the semester the student is accepted (unless that is summer semester; then the students will need to complete a summer aid application, otherwise, the scholarship will begin in the fall semester). Students must be enrolled and attend on a full-time basis each semester the award is used (although see below for renewal requirements). The award must be used for consecutive semesters.
2. The maximum length of this scholarship is eight (8) semesters, not to exceed five consecutive calendar years or the completion of a baccalaureate degree, whichever comes first.
3. One-half of the yearly award will be applied to the student's bill each fall and spring semester to help pay for full-time tuition and general fee (up to 18 credit hours per semester). Additional awards of other grants, scholarships, or benefits restricted to tuition and general fee may reduce the amount of this scholarship or may allow this scholarship to be applied to University room and board charges. This scholarship is considered non-refundable except for institutionally approved expenses including but not limited to study abroad.
4. This scholarship will be used toward the payment of costs incurred at The University of Toledo and is not transferable to any other college or university. The housing portion of this award is to be used for an on-campus University of Toledo residence hall and is equal to the cost of a double occupancy room. This award cannot be used toward housing charges at Honors Academic Village.
5. This scholarship could be adjusted or rescinded if the student is a recipient of an athletic scholarship.
6. Academic year requirements for scholarship recipients enrolled in degree programs that require a mandatory co-op or internship experience will be adjusted as needed. Students will need to contact the Scholarship Office at FinancialAidScholarship@utoledo.edu.
7. Yearly renewal is based on a 2.75 cumulative GPA and successful completion of 24 credit hours within two semesters of the academic year.
 - The academic year begins with the summer semester and ends with the spring semester. Annual review for renewal will be at the end of each spring term, unless placed on a term by term review.
 - Exceptions to these parameters may be reviewed individually for students who provide documentation regarding special circumstances.
 - Renewal requirements are subject to change at any time. Notice would be provided through students' Rocket email accounts.
