

**The University of Toledo**  
**Scholarship Terms and Conditions for the Out-of-State Assistance Award,  
Transfer Out-of-State Assistance Award, and Online Out-of-State Assistance Award**

1. The awarded scholarship begins in the semester the student is accepted (unless that is summer semester; then the student will need to complete a summer aid application, otherwise, the scholarship will begin in the fall semester). Students must be enrolled and attend on a full-time basis each semester the award is used (although see below for renewal requirements). The award must be used for consecutive semesters.
2. The maximum length of this scholarship is eight (8) semesters, not to exceed five consecutive calendar years or the completion of a baccalaureate degree, whichever comes first.
3. One-half of the yearly award will be applied to the student's bill each fall and spring semester to help pay for the full-time out-of-state surcharge (up to 18 credit hours per semester). Additional awards of other grants, scholarships, or benefits restricted to the OOS surcharge may reduce the amount of this scholarship. This scholarship is considered non-refundable.
4. This scholarship will be used toward the payment of the out-of-state surcharge incurred at The University of Toledo and is not transferable to any other charge or college/university.
5. This scholarship is awarded based on financial need and other criteria. Consequently, it could be adjusted or rescinded if the student's financial need changes due to the receipt of an athletic scholarship or other institutional awards including, but not limited to, the UT Legacy Award, UT Sibling Award, or Marching Band Member Scholarship.
6. Academic year requirements for scholarship recipients enrolled in degree programs that require a mandatory co-op or internship experience will be adjusted as needed. Students will need to contact the Scholarship Office at *Financialaidsscholarship@utoledo.edu*.
7. Renewal Process:
  - The academic year begins with the summer semester and ends with the spring semester. Annual review for renewal will be at the end of each spring term, unless placed on a term by term review.
  - Scholarships are automatically renewed if the student maintains a 2.5 cumulative GPA and earns 27 UT credit hours within two semesters of the academic year.
  - Students on an approved co-op/internship during two semesters of the academic year are required to maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA and earn 12 UT credit hours during their one semester of coursework.
  - Students who do not meet the automatic renewal criteria outlined above but who earn at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA and 22 UT credit hours within two semesters of the academic year are able to appeal their scholarship. If approved, the scholarship can be renewed at variable percentages of the original award amount.
  - Exceptions to these parameters may be reviewed individually for students who provide documentation regarding special circumstances.
  - Renewal requirements are subject to change at any time. Notice would be provided through students' Rocket email accounts.
