

Important Parking Information



- **Your license plate serves as your permit. If you change vehicles, update your plate information in your [parking portal](#).**
- **You may have up to four vehicles associated with one parking permit. However, if two or more vehicles are scanned on campus within three hours of each other, a shared permit citation will be issued to BOTH vehicles.**
- **Only park in spaces designated for your specific permit; each parking area has signs indicating which permits are valid.**
- **Park with your license plate facing the drive aisle - if you don't have a front license plate, you can't pull through or back into a parking space.**
- **All vehicles must be parked in a lined parking space.**
- **Spaces marked with gold/yellow markings are reserved for faculty & staff "A" permits.**
- **Spaces marked with green markings are reserved for patient parking.**
- **Family, friends and additional visitors can park in most areas by using the [ParkMobile App](#). Hourly parking is also available for purchase at metered spots.**

On weekdays from 5PM-7AM and on Saturdays & Sundays, active permits may park in areas designated for other permits. Exceptions include: reserved, disabled, metered, patient and no overnight parking areas.
