



## **Call for Applications and Nominations**

### **Faculty Fellow –College of Graduate Studies (Main Campus)**

Vice Provost and Dean of the College of Graduate Studies (COGS) Patricia Komuniecki is seeking applications and nominations for the position of Faculty Fellow in the MC COGS office. The Faculty Fellow will hold a one- or two-semester (to be arranged by mutual agreement), half-time appointment to begin as soon as possible.

The successful candidate will be a tenured professor or associate professor from a graduate program in a college reporting to the Main Campus Provost who is interested in gaining administrative experience in key areas in graduate education. The candidate must be a full member of the Graduate Faculty and have had experience in mentoring masters and doctoral students and teaching graduate courses. The Vice Provost/Dean will assign the Faculty Fellow special initiatives on which to focus during the coming academic year. This experience is designed to provide him/her with mentoring as well as valuable experience and insight about academic administration. For the duration of the appointment, the Faculty Fellow will have an office in the MC COGS administrative suite (UHall 3190).
