

By 2020, the BLS estimates that the number of jobs requiring advanced degrees will increase by 2.5 million.

- •18% increase in jobs requiring a masters degree
- •17% increase in jobs requiring a doctoral degree

#### Impact of Graduate Students on UT

It has been previously calculated that each UT graduate assistant has an average ROI of \$121,188.

Recently, \$500,000 was invested to fund 37 new graduate assistantships. It expected that these new assistantships will have a total ROI of \$4,483,936.


The University of Toledo was founded in 1872 and has 125 masters programs and 35 doctoral and first professional degrees.



## The University of Toledo Graduate Student Population






