1. *Rationale for name change:*

We are requesting to change the name of the Curriculum and Instruction doctoral specification area from Elementary to Early Childhood Education. We are requesting this change because the term “elementary” is dated in regards to working with young children and does not reflect the age range of birth to 8 years of age. We believe that using the term “early childhood education” is a truer representation of what the program entails than the term “elementary”

We don’t believe it will have any effect on students in the current program. When approved, we will give doctoral students enrolled in the current C&I: “Elementary” program the option of changing to the “Early Childhood Education” program.
