May serve on, but may not chair Master or Doctoral advisory committees and comprehensive examination committees. 2. May serve on, or chair, Scholarly Project committees; may direct internships. 3. May teach graduate level courses (excluding thesis/dissertation research). 4. May vote in elections pertaining to Graduate Council and graduate education matters but may not serve on the Graduate Council. 	<p>Associate I membership can be reviewed within three years. Hold a regular continuing faculty appointment at the University of Toledo. 3. Be qualified to engage in teaching and service at the graduate level. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. May serve on, but may not chair Scholarly Project, Master or Doctoral advisory committees and comprehensive examination committees. 2. May teach graduate level courses (excluding thesis/dissertation research). 3. May vote in elections pertaining to Graduate Council and graduate education matters but may not serve on the Graduate Council. 	<p>Associate II membership shall be reviewed within three years. Possess an advanced degree or earned distinction for Adjunct membership on the Main Campus; Possess an earned Master degree for Adjunct membership on the Health Science Campus. 2. Does not hold a regular continuing faculty appointment at the University of Toledo. Adjunct membership may be held by visiting and part-time faculty, lecturers, part-time clinical or visiting appointees, and fellows. 3. Adjunct membership must be for a specified period of time for those professionals who would make a significant contribution to graduate education, research, and service. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. May teach graduate level courses. 2. May serve on, but may not chair Scholarly Project, Master or Doctoral advisory committees and comprehensive examination committees. 3. May not vote in elections pertaining to Graduate Council or graduate education matters nor serve on the Graduate Council. 	<p>Adjunct members are appointed for a specific period of time but in no case greater than three years. Adjunct Membership be renewed upon recommendations of the Membership Committee.</p>
Special	<p>On the recommendation of the Dean of the Graduate College, the Membership Committee will consider granting Special Membership to professionals who would make a significant contribution to graduate education or research.</p>	<p>Special members of the Graduate Faculty will be given responsibilities as enumerated by the Membership Committee from the Duties and Privileges of the Full Membership with the exceptions that individuals holding Special Membership will not vote in elections pertaining to Graduate Council or graduate education matters and will not serve on the Graduate Council.</p>	<p>Appointment for a specific period of time but in no case greater than three years. This membership category may be renewed.</p>
