DESCRIBE PROGRAM:

A four course interprofessional series of courses (SOCW 6700, CRIM 6710, COUN 6720, CRIM 6730) are designed to provide interested students with an understanding of the causes and prevention of child maltreatment and neglect; the ability to identify child neglect, maltreatment and abuse; knowledge of systems responses to child abuse and neglect; exploration of ethical, legal, and moral issues regarding child safety; development of tools for child advocacy; and applied experiences in selected issues of child advocacy. Students who complete the program of four courses with a 3.0 gpa will be awarded a certificate and may obtain the certificate as part of a degree program or as a stand-alone certificate.
