The M.A. degree (literature concentration) requires 33 hours of course work. Teaching Assistants are further required to take English 6010 - Seminar in English Instruction: Composition, which is an additional three-hour course, for a total of 36 hours.

a.) The course work shall include English 5100 - History of the English Language; either English 5750 - History of Literary Criticism OR English 5780 - Contemporary Literary Theories and Criticism; English 5790 - Approaches to Research in English; and two seminars (excluding instructional seminars).

b.) Of the remaining 18 hours of course work for the degree, students may take a maximum of two courses from other departments in the humanities, fine arts or social sciences, as approved by the director. Students may count two creative writing courses and one independent study course toward the degree.

c.) Students are required to demonstrate a reading knowledge of at least one foreign language. Passing a special exam administered by the department of foreign languages will satisfy this requirement.
